This Week's Worship and Reflection



"All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit." Acts 2:4a

This week we celebrate Pentecost: the coming of the Holy Spirit. This day marks fifty days since Easter Day and brings the Church's Easter season to an end. Pentecost is a special day when we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit - first given to Jesus' friends and

followers – and how it turned those ordinary people into people who did amazing things for God.

Pentecost is also known as 'the birthday of the Church', because the gift of the Holy Spirit transformed Jesus' friends and followers into His new Church. The Holy Spirit moved them into action, filling them with the power of God and enabling them to tell the story of God in ways that everyone listening could understand. How amazing!

And this is so amazing precisely because what started with Jesus and his disciples didn't stop with them in the Bible's Pentecost story (which is in Acts 2:1-21). This gift of the Holy Spirit is just as much ours today, and indeed for anyone who receives Jesus as Lord and Saviour into their hearts and lives. As Christians, it's what fills us up when we are empty, heals us when we are broken, and fires us up when we are despairing. It's God within us.

The Holy Spirit powered Jesus' ministry and will empower us too, the ordinary folk of Bottesford and around, to do amazing things for God. So let us celebrate together this Pentecost, eat cake (on the Church's birthday!) and be thankful that God's Spirit of life renews us, so that we can go out and serve in the world. Happy birthday everyone! Amen.
